How does Spokane Firefighters Credit Union collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you open an account apply for a loan use your credit or debit card pay your bills make deposits to or withdrawals from the accounts you have with us We also collect your personal information from others, including credit bureaus or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law only gives you the right to limit: sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
