

THE RUDY MEAD SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Russell (Rudy) Mead served on the Supervisory Committee of Spokane Firefighters Credit Union from his appointment on July 10th, 1956 until his last meeting, March 25th, 2008, almost 52 years. Rudy's commitment to our organization, his strong work ethic and sense of community embody the spirit of our organization. We have created a scholarship to honor his memory.

Each year, the Spokane Firefighters Credit Union will award up to two (2) scholarships valued at \$1,000 each to dependent students of SFCU members.

The scholarships will be awarded to students who will graduate high school in the current school year and will enroll in an accredited college or university (either 2 or 4 year) in the fall of the same year or is currently enrolled in an accredited college or university.

Applications will not be accepted for enrollment as a part-time student, for vocational or trade schools or for adult remedial education courses.

by **April 1st** of each year and must include a current transcript of the high school or college academic record. Application must be complete to be considered.

Applications will be judged on:

- Academic Achievement
- Financial Need
- Declaration of Career Goals
- Extracurricular Activities
- Reference letters

In case of a tie(s) the SFCU Scholarship Committee shall award based upon financial need.

Scholarship awards will be presented annually.
